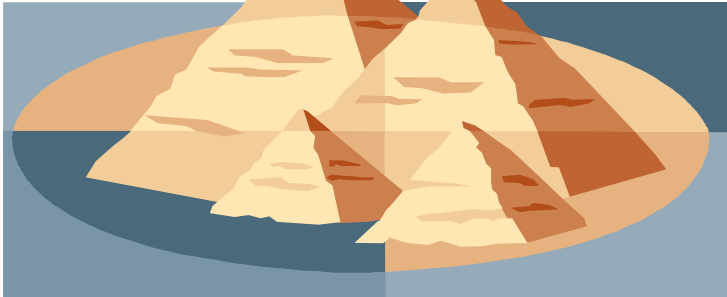
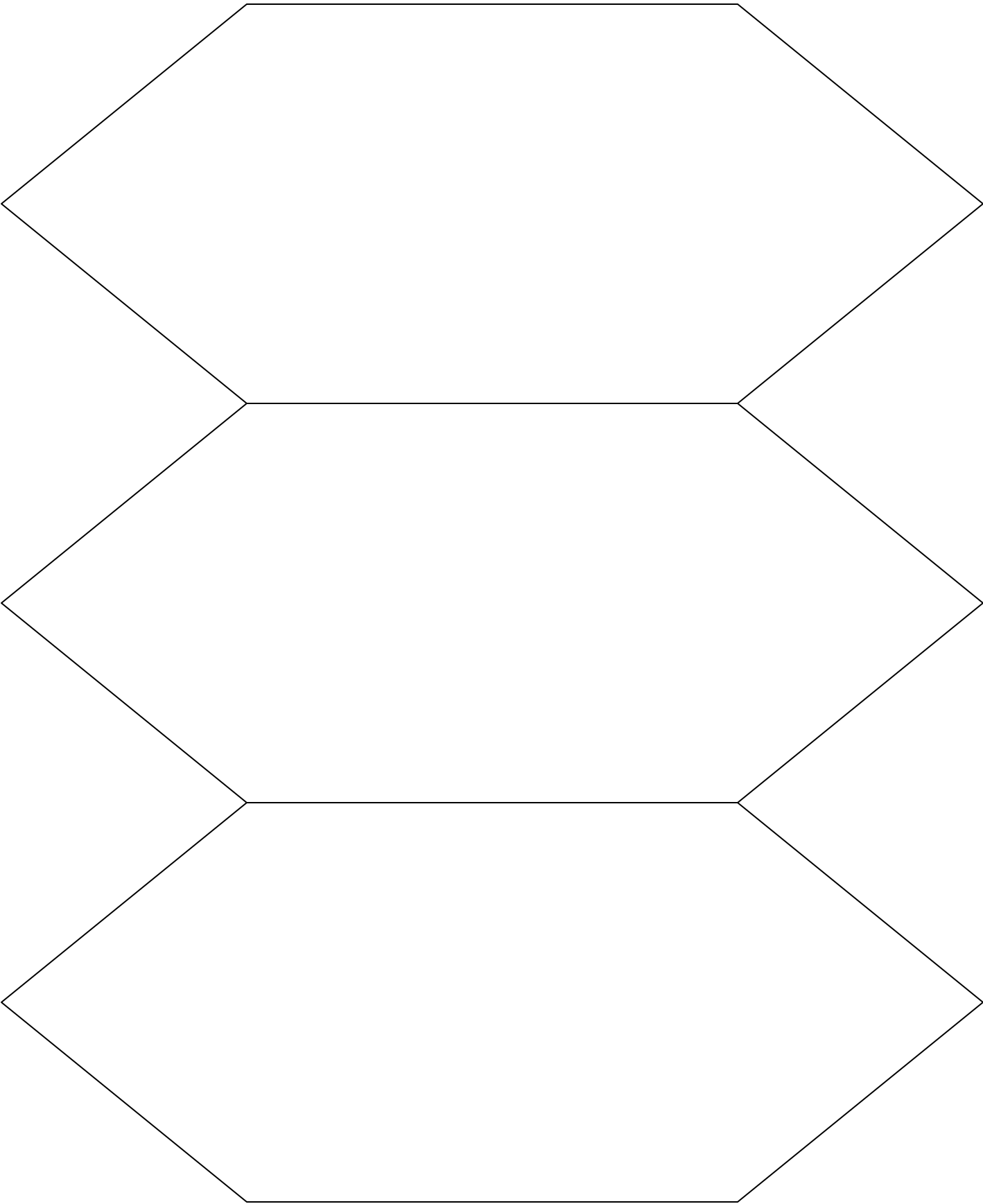


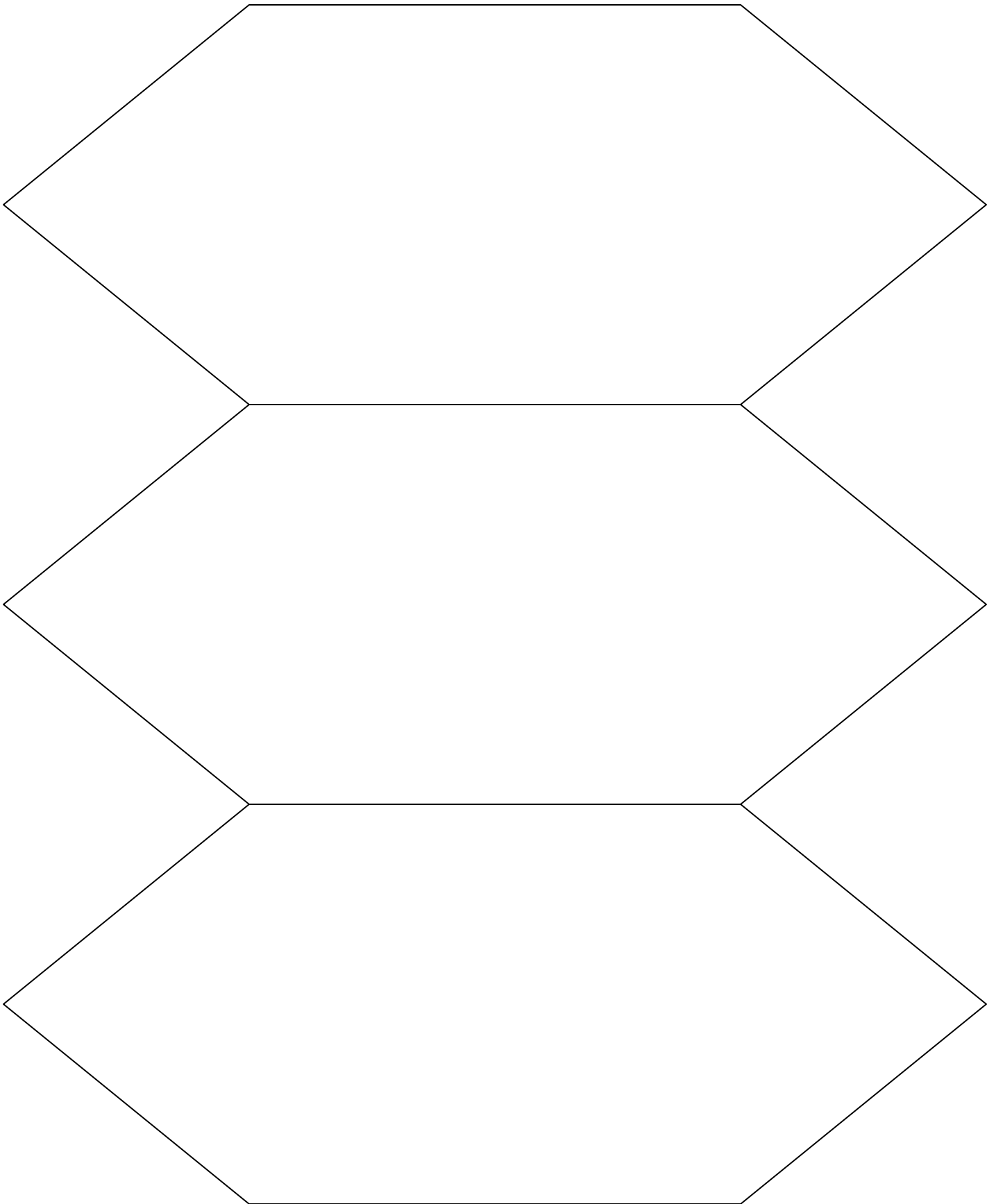

# Pyramids

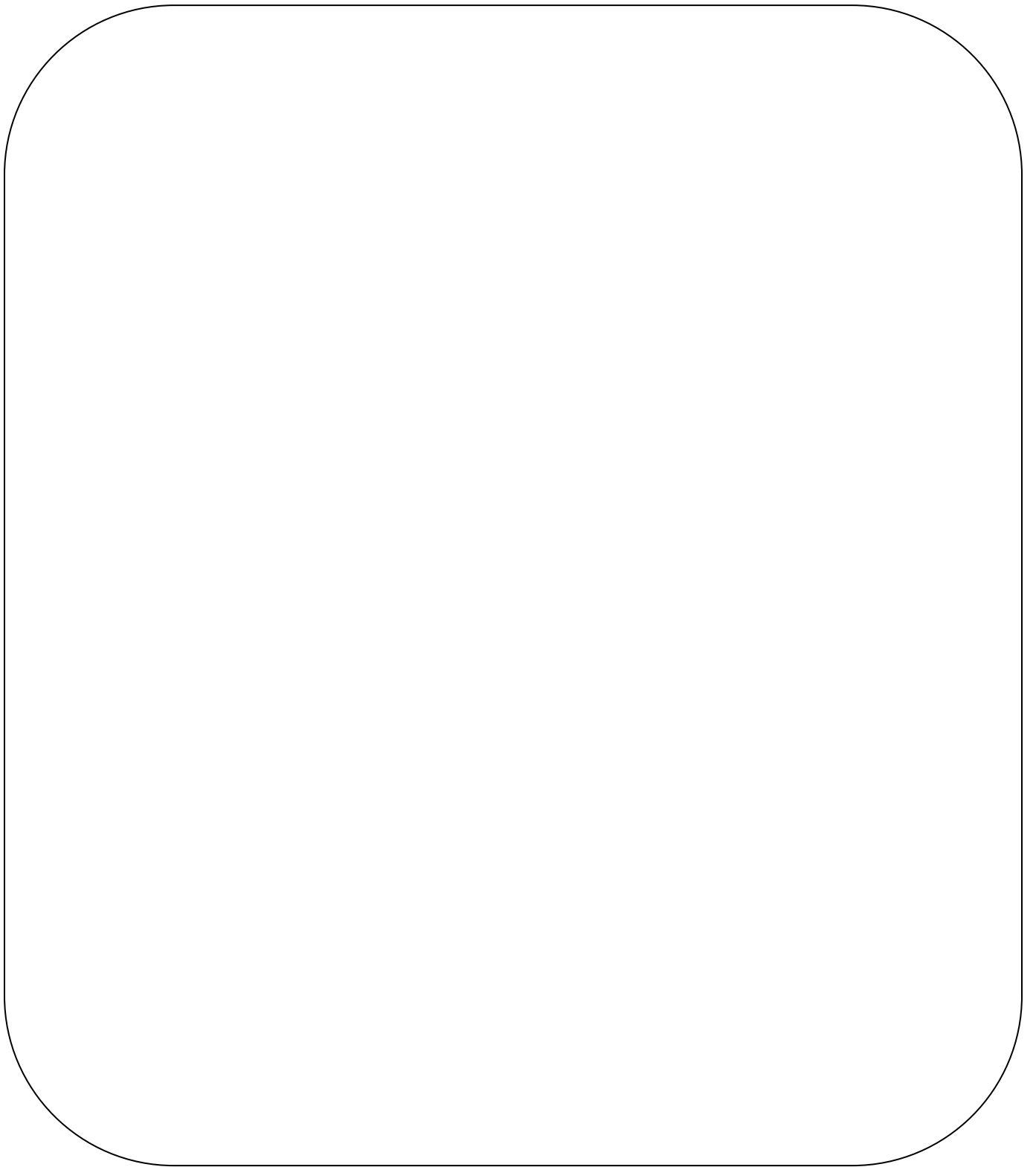

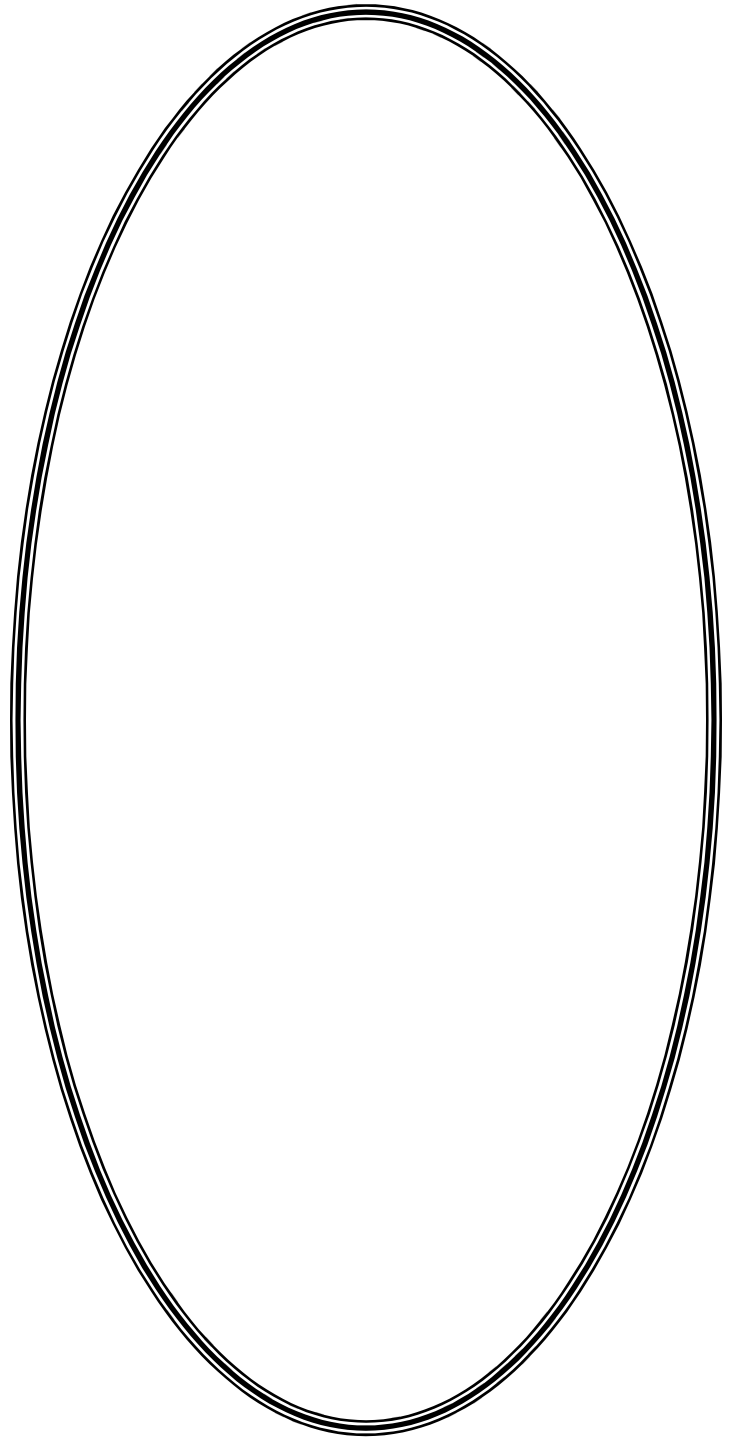
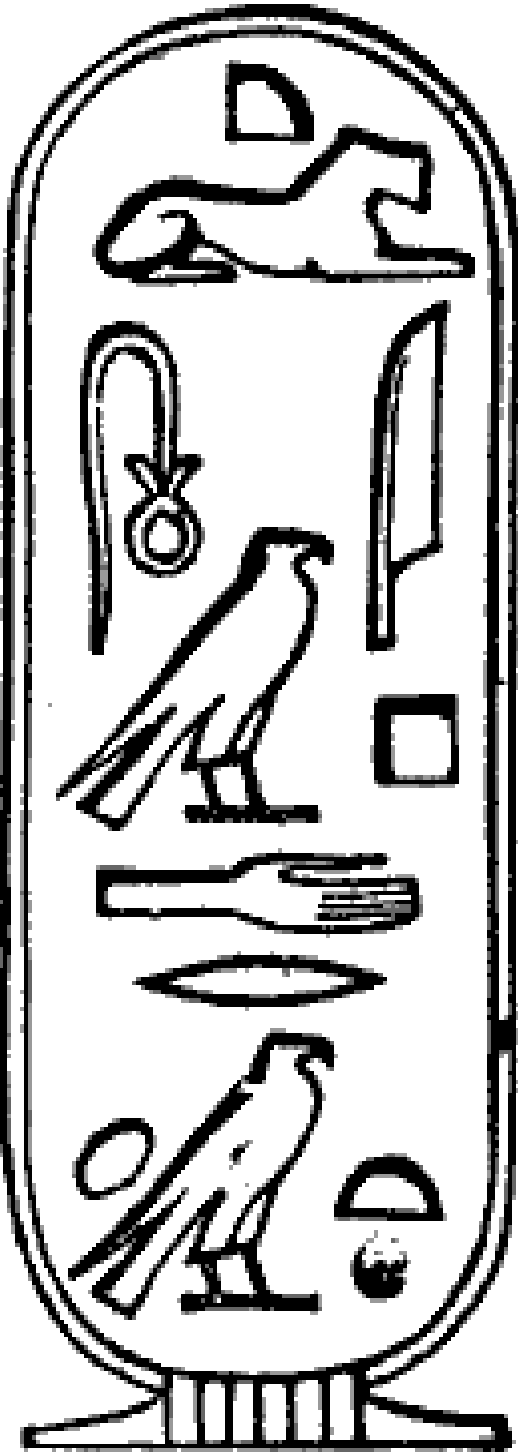




Activity 1 – this is to draw your map on. Then cut out and fold in half to form mini-book

Fan fold – cut out each shape and attach together with brass fastener



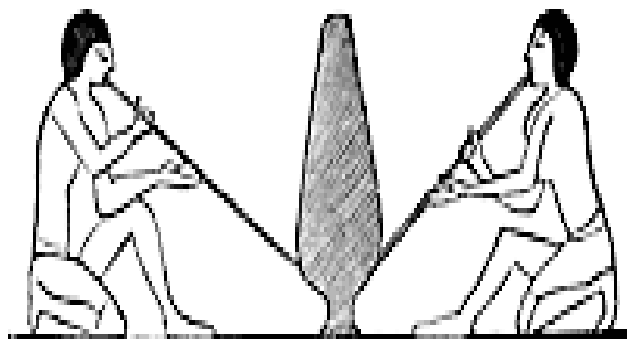
