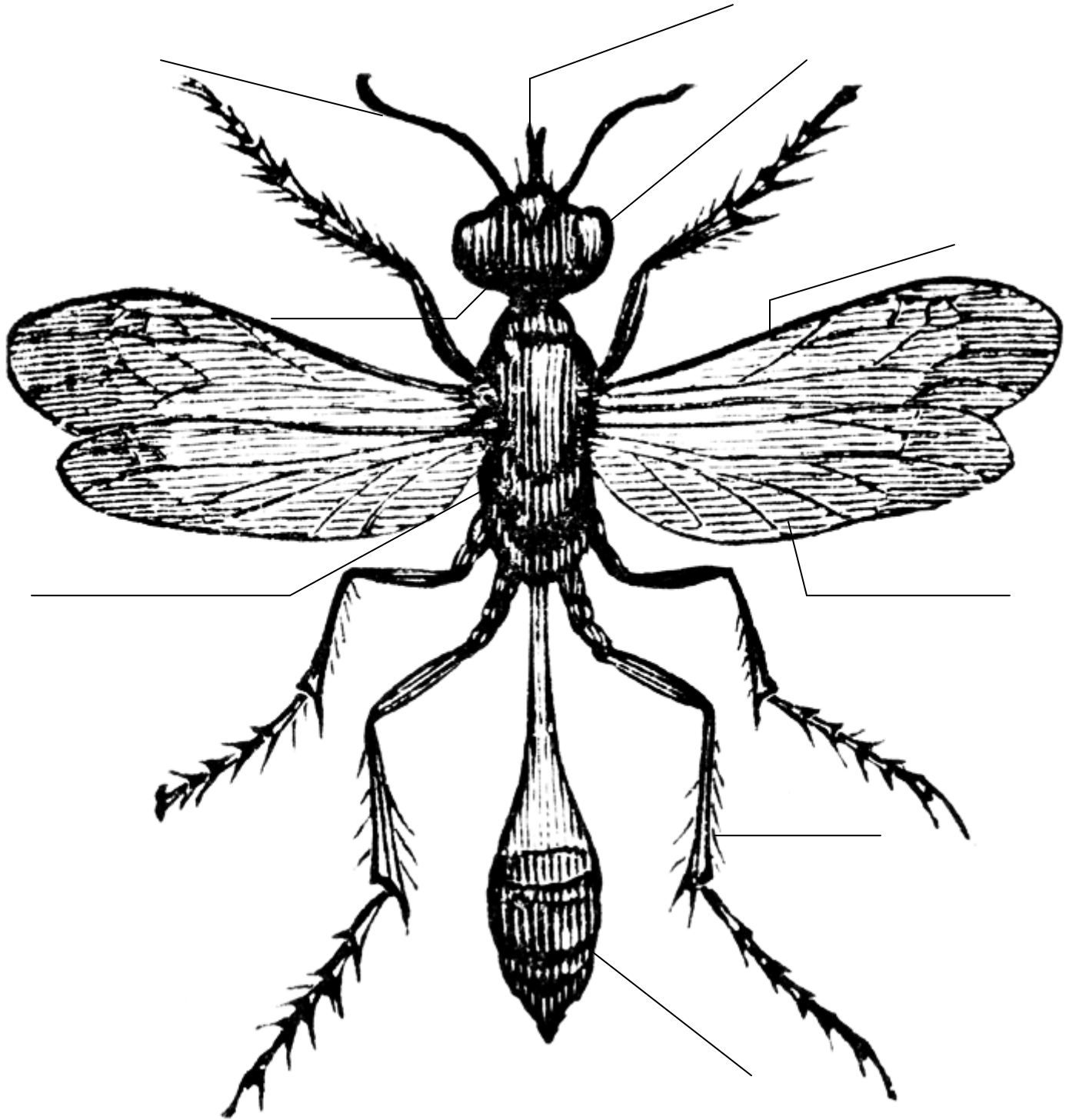


Cut out each vocabulary card and staple together to form a mini-book.

Label these parts: compound eye, antennae, head, thorax, abdomen, mouth, forewing, hind wing

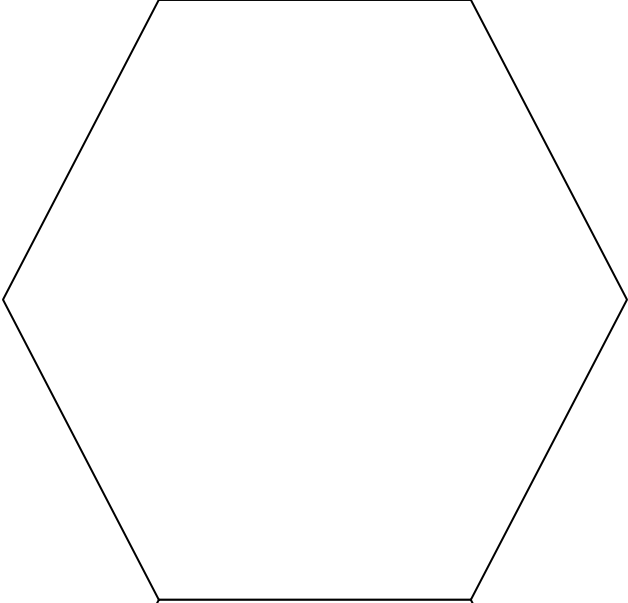
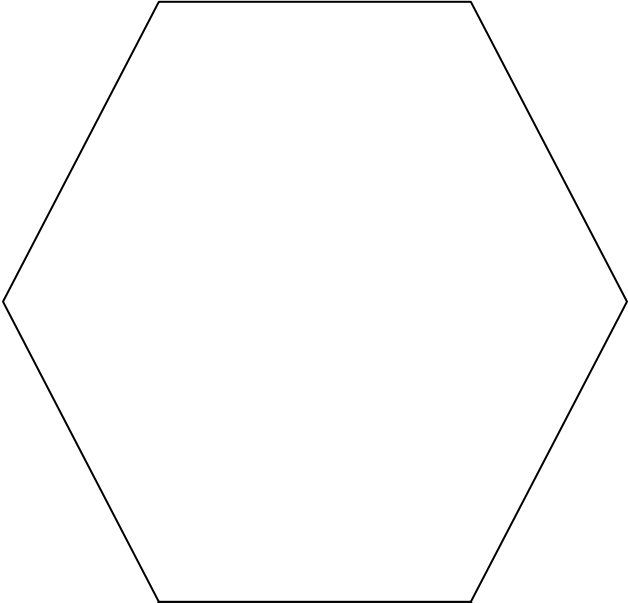
